The fee for this year's tournament is \$100 per archer, and a late fee will be \$25 per archer. A T-shirt and Banquet Ticket will be included as part of the registration fee. Additional shirts can be purchased for \$20 each. Banquet Tickets for non-team members (coaches, parents, friends, etc...) will be \$25 each. Extra shirts and Banquet Tickets need to be purchased before the registration deadline to ensure availability. It will be an additional \$15 per person total for two (2) nights of fun: The Thursday Night Pool Party and Saturday Night Sledding (yes even in Texas).

**The registration deadline for the tournament is April 13, 2010 (postmark date to avoid the late fee).** All meal tickets (Awards Banquet, Pool Party, and Cookout) must be purchased by May 1. Only a limited amount of tickets will be available after this date.

**Cancellations/Refunds:** Cancellations prior to May 1, 2010 will receive a refund less 20%. No refunds after May 1, 2010 will be given.

### **Airports:**

The nearest airport is [Easterwood Airport \(CLL\)](#) located 4 miles west of the campus on Highway 60. American and Sky West service it. ### Accommodations:

Manor Inn (\$110.00). To reserve your room and get the tournament rate, call (800) 231-4100 or (979) 764-9540. Let them know you are with the **US Archery Nationals** block. The block will be reserved up to a month prior to the event (April 12, 2010).

The New Ramada (\$149.00). To reserve your room and get the tournament rate call (832) 453-1253. Request rooms listed under **Archery Nationals**. The block will be reserved until April 1, 2010. Please note that this is a brand new hotel and will not be open until April 1<sup>st</sup>. The manager is taking reservations on his personal cell phone to work with the USIAC event. ### Tournament Site:

The site of the 2010 United States Intercollegiate Archery Championships will be the lacrosse fields on the west side of the A&M campus next to the tennis courts.

**Directions from Austin:** Take highway 290 east to highway 21. Turn left on highway 21 and continue to almost to Bryan. Turn south or right on highway 47 and then left or east on highway 60. Turn right onto 2818 and then left on George Bush Drive. Turn left at the next light (Olsen Rd.). Turn left at the 4-way stop sign. Drive past the intramural fields and into the paved parking lot at the end of the road and park. The archery field is just south of Mount Aggie (our Texas ski slope).

**Directions from Houston:** Take I-45 north to Conroe. Turn west on highway 105 to Navasota. Turn north on Highway 6 at Navasota. Get on business 6 (also called Texas Ave.) at the south end of College Station. Turn left on George Bush Drive. Cross Welborn road and then the railroad tracks. Take the next right (Olsen Road). Turn left at the 4-way stop sign. Drive past the intramural fields and into the paved parking lot at the end of the road and park. The archery field is just south of Mount Aggie (our Texas ski slope).

### World University Archery Championships Information:

World University Archery Championship (WUAC) Team Trials are conducted in conjunction with USIAC. The WUAC team will be selected from the Qualifying portion of the USIAC, which is a double 70 meter round (144 arrows at 70m). The top three (3) in each class (men/women recurve; men/women compound) will make up the team. If someone does not choose to attend the WUAC, then the next qualified person will be offered the opportunity to participate.

Athletes must meet eligibility rules, including a 2.0 GPA (3.0 for graduate students), be full-time students at a university/college and be pursuing a degree. The fee is the USIAC registration fee, which is \$100.00 and includes the banquet.

The WUAC will be in Shenzhen, China from 23-26 September 2010. All athletes must have current passports at the time of the trials. The passport expiration date must be after 30 March 2011. Athletes must commit to attending WUAC (September 21-27, 2010) at the end of the team trials and attend a team meeting and a team training if mandated by the WUAC staff. Athletes will be required to pay a \$100 per person damage deposit. The deposit will be refunded when the team returns to the U.S. minus any charges for damage to the rooms. This trip is 100% funded by US Collegiate Archery from the USCA grant provided by Easton Foundations.

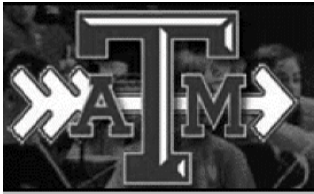

**USCA Rules and Regulations:**

- USCA and the FITA Dress code will be enforced for all coaches and participants including Official Practice day.
- FITA Rules will apply to team round, mixed team round, qualifying round and Olympic Round (elimination round)
- There have been significant changes made to the rules by FITA, particularly regarding Elimination rounds and the new 'match set' format. 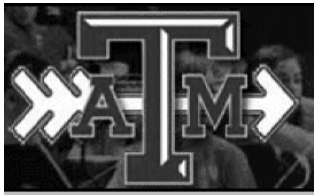

- By signing this form, the participant affirms having read the College Division/USA Archery Code of Conduct.
- Send this completed Release form to the USIAC Tournament Director with the entry forms.

I pledge to, at all time, conduct myself in a manner that will not in any way draw disrespect to either myself or my association. I agree to conform to all local, state, and federal laws and regulations and any rules and regulations that may be established for participation in this year's USIAC.

I will at all times display the conduct expected of me as an athlete and representative of USA Archery. This is conduct that will not bring discredit upon USA Archery, USCA, the U.S. Olympic Committee or my country. I realize that if I choose to take actions other than those described above, I will be subject to disciplinary action.

I also realize that the consequences of my actions could possibly affect my opportunities as an athlete and USA Archery member in future years.

The following could result in disciplinary proceedings:

1. Transporting, possession or unauthorized use of illegal drugs, or IOC-banned substances while involved in the above event.
2. Any physical damage to a facility or loss of items in a room where I am lodged during the event will be paid for by those individuals assigned to the room in which the damage or loss occurs.
3. Unacceptable behavior will not be tolerated, including, but not limited to, the following:
  - a. Any act considered to be an offense under federal, state or local laws, or a violation of USA Archery or USOC policies and procedures.
  - b. Gross misconduct (i.e., inappropriate horseplay, theft, fighting, etc.)
  - c. Willful destruction of property (including that caused horseplay, fighting, etc.)
